### The following must be submitted with the completed application:

- 1) Recent Photograph
- 2) Government ID or Copy of Passport
- 3) Copy of results of test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL). Proof of having passed the test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) with an Internet base test minimum score of 79-80. Paper base test minimum score is 550 points. TOEFL results are valid for two years only. Medical students that have passed any of the United States Medical Licensing Examinations (USMLE) do not need to take the TOEFL.
- 4) Original medical school transcript (grades) from beginning of Medical career.
- 5) A letter of recommendation from the Dean of your medical school
- 6) One letter of recommendation from the Chairman of the Department of Medicine, the Director of Medical Curriculum, Or Director of Clinical Rotations
- 7) Curriculum Vitae (in English) including list of publications.
- 8) A brief essay describing your future long-term plans (10-15 years from now) in the medical profession **\*Your long term** plans should include where you intend to train, practice medicine, and the type of practice of your interest: private, research, academic or a combination.
- 9) Enclose payment in the amount of \$75 to cover application processing fee charge.
