Paper base test minimum score is 550 points. TOEFL results are valid for two years only. Medical students that have passed any of the United States Medical Licensing

- Examinations (USMLE) do not need to take the TOEFL.
- 4) Original medical school transcript (grades) from beginning of Medical career.
- A letter of recommendation from the Dean of your medical school 5)
- 6) One letter of recommendation from the Chairman of the Department of Medicine, the Director of Medical Curriculum, Or Director of Clinical Rotations
- 7) Curriculum Vitae (in English) including list of publications.
- A brief essay describing your future long-term plans (10-15 years from now) in the medical profession *Your long term 8) plans should include where you intend to train, practice medicine, and the type of practice of your interest: private, research, academic or a combination.
